

RESOLUTION NO. 0105A RESOLUTION OF CARIBOU COUNTY ADOPTING THE
OREGON TRAIL-BEAR LAKE SCENIC BYWAY
CORRIDOR MANAGEMENT PLAN - 2001

WHEREAS, Caribou County joined with Bear Lake County, and the cities of Soda Springs, Montpelier, Bloomington, Paris, St. Charles, and Georgetown and regional economic development agencies to initiate a Corridor Management Plan to promote appreciation of the Oregon Trail-Bear Lake Scenic Byway and economic development opportunities in the region; and

WHEREAS, Caribou County participated in the preparation of the Corridor Plan through a byway management team; and

WHEREAS, public meetings and hearings were held to review the Corridor Plan; and

WHEREAS, after a revised Corridor Plan was presented and reviewed by the Caribou Board of County Commissioners; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Corridor Management Plan dated June 2001 is adopted as the Oregon-Trail-Bear Lake Scenic Byway Corridor Management Plan to be used as a guide for the present and future development of the Byway, effective the date of this Resolution.
