

COMMISSIONER MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2009


The Caribou County Commissioners met in ^{special} ~~regular~~ session on September 1, 2009, at 9:00 a.m. Those in attendance were Lloyd Rasmussen, Commissioner Chairman, Earl Somsen and Phil Christensen Commissioners. Also in attendance were Clerk of the Board Veda Mascarenas, County Attorney Gregg Haney, Ric Anderson, Caribou County Sheriff, and Mike Haderlie.

Ric Anderson, Caribou County Sheriff meet with the board of commissioners to discuss the issues from the incident at the jail last week. The sheriff has meet with ICRMP in Boise to review the incident. ICRMP has determined that there is no criminal or negligence on the part of Caribou County Sheriff's Office. ICRMP and ISA have determined that the jail is short 2 dispatchers and 2 jailers.

Discussion was also about: (1) City of Soda Springs to help pay for part-time dispatchers (2) getting Oneida County to contract with us again to house their prisoners

After much discussion, it is the conclusion that screens and monitors will be replaced, the sheriff will use patrolmen as jailers during busy times, and will hire part-time dispatchers or volunteers to watch the holding cell monitors and pods if deemed necessary..
